Christian Elin, born 1976 in Munich, whose playing modulates masterfully in intensity (Rheinische Post), praised by the critics as "Sensational" (Süddeutsche Zeitung) places great emphasis on diversity in his working as saxophonist, bass clarinetist and composer.

As one of the most sought-after classical saxophonists, he is a regular guest of the leading symphony orchestras of Germany such as the Bavarian Radio Orchestra and the Munich Philharmonic Orchestra. In addition he is often on the stage internationally as a soloist and chamber musician.

In his compositions, Christian Elin unifies influences from jazz, filr music and classic, to form his own distinct voice.

In his solo programme "streaming", he succeeds in making a single saxophone sound like a whole orchestra, inspired by the idea of Minimal Music and through complete technical mastership and taking the listener on a meditative journey, which is touching and instills inspiration.
